



GDC MODIFIED VISITATION PROCEDURES



SCHEDULING

APPROVED VISITORS WILL REQUEST VISITATION BY ACCESSING THE FORM ON OUR WEBSITE AT GDC.GA.GOV

Scheduling requests may be submitted from 5:00 AM Monday - 5:00 PM Wednesday only for that week's visitation.

Inmates with last names beginning A - L will visit on Saturday

9:00 AM - 11:00 AM – Saturday Session 1

1:00 PM - 3:00 PM – Saturday Session 2

Inmates with last names beginning M - Z will visit on Sunday

9:00 AM - 11:00 AM – Sunday Session 1

1:00 PM - 3:00 PM – Sunday Session 2

- One (1) visit every other month per inmate will be allowed
- Visits will be no more than two (2) hours in length
- Two (2) approved visitors will be allowed and must visit at the same time
- No visitors under the age of twelve (12) will be permitted
- All visitors must be on the offenders approved visitation list
- An email will be sent from gdcvisitationnoreply@gdc.ga.gov once your request for visitation has been approved
- Offenders on quarantine or medical isolation status will not be allowed visits



ENTRY AND SCREENING

UPON ARRIVAL, VISITORS WILL PARK IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA AND REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE

- A GDC staff member will distribute laminated visitor numbers to each vehicle
- At your designated time, the number you have been provided will be displayed by the staff member, indicating you may leave your vehicle and proceed to the front entry
- Personal face coverings/masks and money must remain in your vehicle
- GDC issued disposable masks will be provided to each visitor

ONLY TWO (2) APPROVED VISITORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FRONT ENTRY AT A TIME

- Once in the front entry, you will receive a visitor badge and disposable face mask which must be worn at all times
- Only GDC issued masks may be worn inside the facility
- All visitors must complete and sign an attestation form of no-known-illness
- All visitors will be subjected to a temperature check to confirm temperatures are not greater than 100.4°
- Any visitor exhibiting symptoms, unable to clear attestation form, or unable to clear temperature screening will not be allowed to visit.



SAFETY AND SANITATION

VISITATION ROOM CAPACITY WILL BE LIMITED TO TEN (10) OFFENDERS, AND TWO (2) VISITORS EACH, FOR A MAXIMUM OF THIRTY (30) PEOPLE

- Disposable face masks will be provided, and must be worn at all times
- Seating will be socially distanced at twelve (12) feet apart
- Barriers separating offenders and loved ones will be in place
- No physical contact will be allowed
- Hand sanitizer will be available
- Vending machines will be closed
- Visitation photos will not be allowed
- Only one (1) person allowed in the restrooms at a time
- Laminated numbers and visitor badges will be sanitized between use
- The restrooms and visitation area will be sanitized between each visitation session
